


Procedures and policies for maintaining and utilizing physical, academic and support facilities - laboratory, library, sports complex, computers, classrooms etc

Physical facilities including laboratories, class rooms, and computer are made available for the students those who are admitted in the college. Students seeking admission to desired courses including a laboratory curriculum are charged for the laboratory expenses at the time of the admission as suggested by university as well as management. The classrooms boards and furniture facilities are utilized regularly by the students. The maintenance and cleaning of the classrooms and the laboratories are done with the efforts of the non-teaching staff. The college garden is maintained by the gardener appointed by the college. The college has adequate number of computers with internet connections and the utility softwares distributed in different locales like office, laboratories, library, departments etc. the library is also provided LAN facility for the computers and they are loaded with the library software. The departments and staff can make use of the computer system with internet at their seating places. The college website is maintained regularly. The maintenance of UPS and the Generator is done regularly. Electrical and plumbing related maintenance is done with the help local skilled persons and the expenditure is done from budget gained by college from different sources. Academic and support facilities: The academic support facilities like library, sports and other platforms supporting overall development of the students like NSS, YRC, career guidance and counseling is open to the students. A provision of the budget for the library maintenance is made by the college management. The activities like fumigation and keeping library clean is done frequently by library staff. The sports department of the college is meritorious and is adequately equipped.
