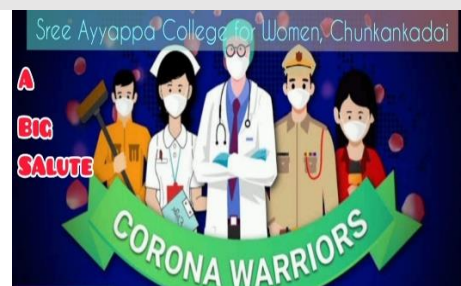
The year 2020 was an unusual and challenging year for the entire human society with significant impacts on local and global economies, and the health and wellbeing of communities worldwide.

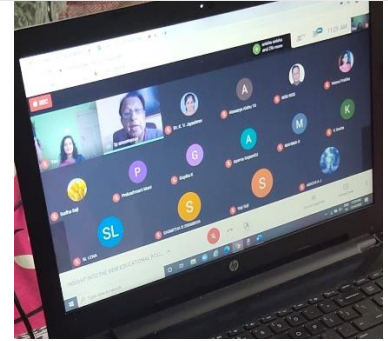
CLUB AND CELL ACTIVITIES

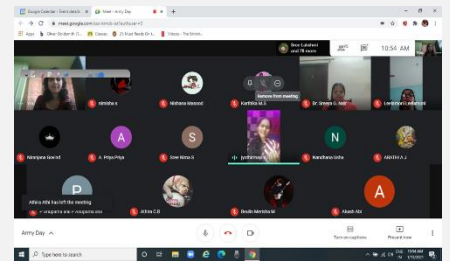
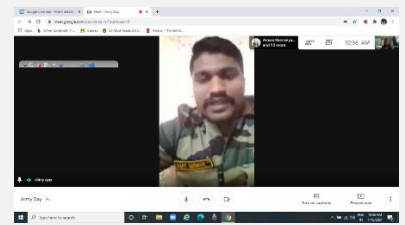
Humans Rights Day, Dec 10
