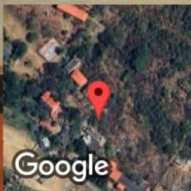

4. **Workshop on Epigraphy from Sangam Age to Medieval Age:-**(08-08-2024 to 09-08-2024)

**Objective:-** The objective of a two day workshop on epigraphy from sangam age to medieval age.

- i) Introduction to epigraphy : to provide a foundational understanding of epigraphy, including its definition and significance
- ii) Reading and analysis: develop skills in reading and interpreting inscription from these periods.
- iii) Hands -on-experience: offer practical sessions where participants can engage with digital images of inscriptions to apply their learning and enhance their interpretative skills.

The department of history organised a two day workshop on Epigraphy from Sangam to medieval age. Mr. E.Mariappan, Director Historical Heritage and field research centre (HFRC), Tirunelveli was the resource person. An exhibition of Epigraphy was also arranged.

**Outcome:** The participants gained an insight into the role of inscriptions in reconstructing historical narratives. The workshop covered the evolution of scripts and languages used including Brahmi Vattazhuthu etc. They also gained practical skill in reading interpreting and analysing various types of inscriptions.
