Dr. Meera, Head of the Department of Physics, and the Organizing Secretary of the event, welcomed all the participants and guests.

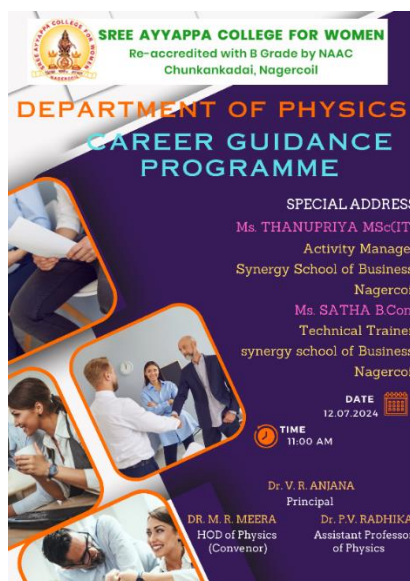

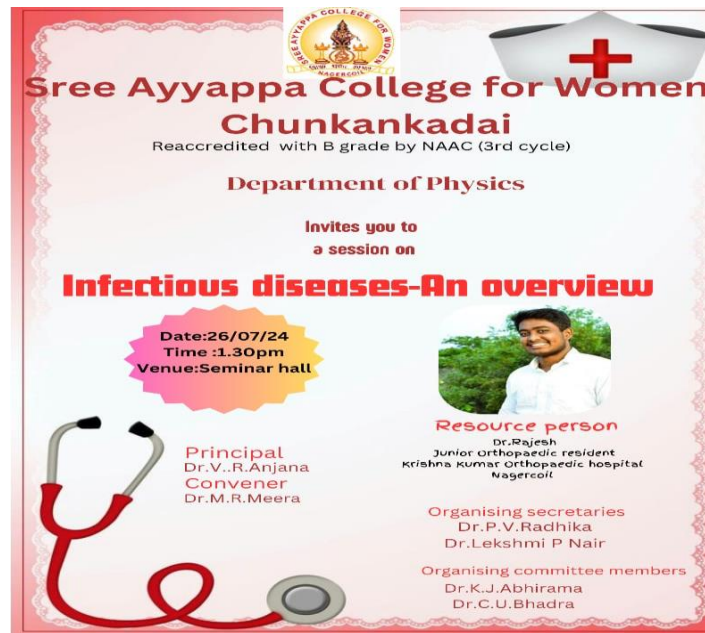

Outcomes:

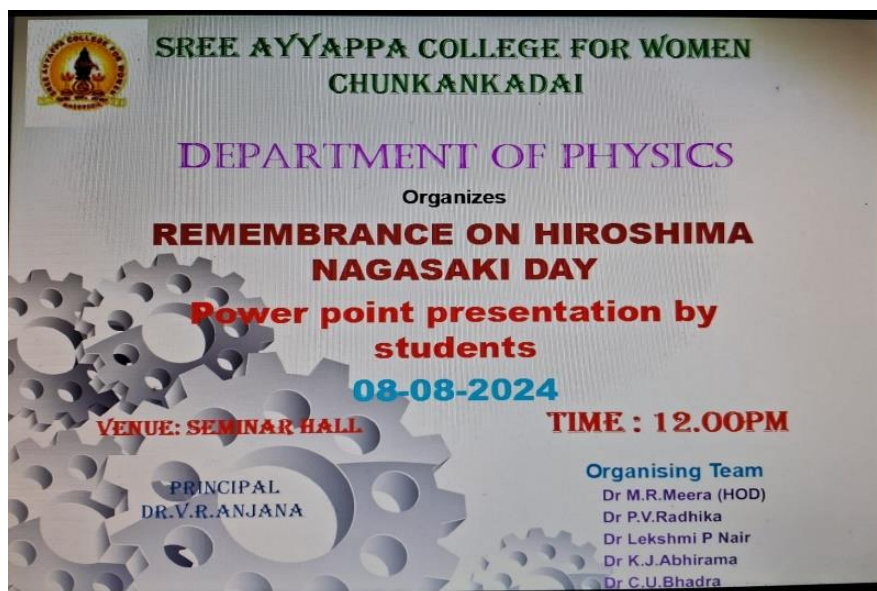

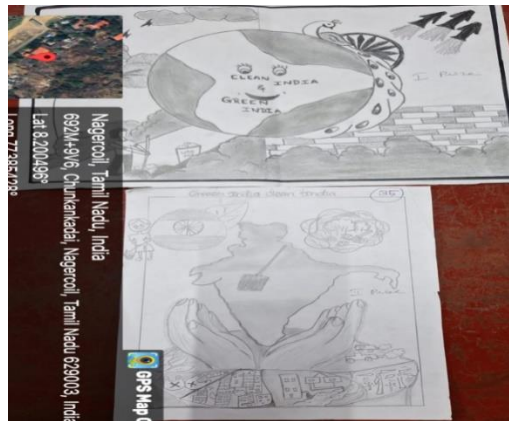
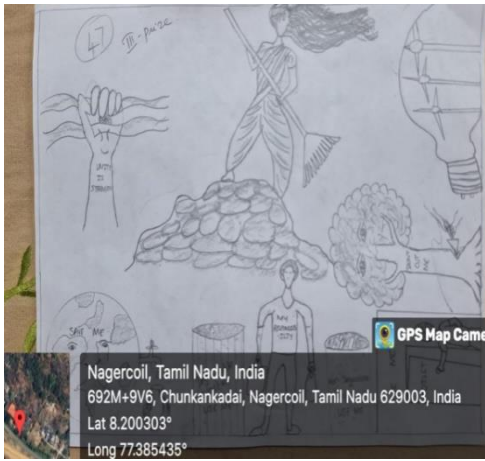
