

She also advised that more students should come forward to donate blood frequently as there has been an increased demand for Blood in Kanyakumari District as patients from adjoining State of Kerala also come to the Hospital for specialized medical treatment. 50 units of blood were donated.



## AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON 'HIV PREVENTION AMONG TRANSEXUAL POPULATIONS: KNOWLEDGE GAPS AND EVIDENCE FOR ACTION''

The Red Ribbon Club of Sree Ayyappa College for Women, Chunkankadai, Kanyakumari District affiliated to Manonmaniam Sundaranar University organized an Awareness Programme on 'HIV Prevention among Transexual Populations: Knowledge Gaps and Evidence for Action" in the College campus on 20 April 2023.Mr. Robert Amalraj, ICTC Counsellor, Primary Health Centre, Kothanalloor in his presentation explained the signs, symptoms, transmission, testing, prevention and treatment of AIDS. It turned out to be a unique programme not only because of the Topic, but also one of the key-speaker was also HIV+. She while highlighting various issues relating to HIV and its prevention, drove home the point that transsexuals formed the most vulnerable segment prone to HIV infections due to the fact that they don't get meaningful employment. She also threw light on lack of awareness among them which required immediate intervention by welfare agencies, both social and health care. The participants and faculty appreciated the organizer for having given them good exposure to hitherto unknown issues.
