It is sad to learn that the lack of regular income from pottery has forced many to look around for jobs that have taken them away from pottery. These people have to travel far to collect mud from the drying pond beds. In most of the Potters houses, the women in the family too sweat it out with their men in beating the pots to shape. The students learned the making of pots which is a long process starting with the selection of clay, seasoning, trimming, molding, painting and finally burning the pots in the kilns. It was an informative program for the students.





❖ Corona Awareness Programme

The Department of English conducted a Corona Virus Awareness Program on 05/02/2020 (Wednesday). The students of second year PG took part in the program and created awareness about corona virus to the people of Potters' Colony in Chunkankadai. The students and the faculty members highlighted some dos and don'ts to prevent oneself from getting infected with Covid 19. 

and inspected all the




❖ ONE DAY INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR ON POSTHUMANISM




