The college offers Graduate courses in Arts, Science and Commerce subjects, Post graduate courses in English, Mathematics and Commerce. 7 UG programmes and 1 PG programme under aided stream and 3 UG courses and 2 PG programmes under Self-financed stream. We have two recognized research centers of MSU in the disciplines English and Mathematics. To equip our students with the essential skills to survive in the competitive world, we conduct Add on courses .

There are **1355** students registered with us, of whom 180 are enrolled in postgraduate programmes. Currently, we have 56 teaching faculty in the aided stream and 23 in the self-supporting stream. Of the teaching staff, 42 hold PhD, and the remaining are pursuing them. With 43 people, the administrative section is composed.

The academic year commenced on **18th July 2022** with II and III UG students and II PG students. Classes for the I year began on **1st August 2022** and I PG classes commenced on 18th.
