

Report of Ganitholsav - '23

Ganitholsav-'23 was conducted in regard of National Mathematics Day on 19 and 20 January 2023. Various Intercollegiate Competitions and Cultural Fest were held. The intercollegiate competitions were held with the objective of aiding the young generations to explore their talents and invoke interest in the subject. We received proactive response form Arts and Science colleges in Tirunelveli and Kanyakumari district. Around 250 participants inclusive of students from MS University and TDMNS college, Kallikulam in Tirunelveli and furthermore 12 Arts and Science colleges in Kanyakumari, competed in 5 events. Competitions including Poster Presentation, Mathematical Modelling, Quiz and Essay Writing were conducted on 19/01/2023. Taking into account that Cultural Fest helps the students bring closer to traditions and cultural beliefs and allows them to highlight their creative ambitions, Folk dance competition was held on 20/01/2023.

On the first day, the inaugural function was presided over by Dr. K. R. Jayasree (Head and Principal-in-charge, Sree Ayyappa College for Women) and was inaugurated by Mrs. N. Krishnammal (Former Head, Department of Mathematics, Holy Cross College; Director, Adithya

Maths Academy, Nagercoil), Dr. C. Sekhar (Department of Mathematics, MS University PG Extension Centre, Vadassery) and Dr. S. Chandrakala (Head, Department of Mathematics, Sree Devi Kumari Women's College, Kuzhiturai). It was followed by Poster Presentation, Mathematical Modelling, Quiz and Essay Writing competitions. A total of 13 teams enrolled for quiz competition, out of which 5 teams were selected by a preliminary test. The quiz master was Dr. S. Chandrakala. On the second day, dance competition was held on morning session which was followed by Valedictory function in the afternoon session. The valedictory section was presided over by Sri. T. Vijaya Kumar, Associate Director, Cognizant, Chennai and Sri.S. Aslin Jeyadev, Manager, Central Bank of India, Aloor branch. Prizes were distributed to the winners of the competitions and participants and trophy was awarded to the overall champions. As part of extension activity, students from Government Primary School, Chunkankadai were tested for Math skills and the top scoring 5 students each from class I, II, III, IV and V were awarded. The two day programme was concluded by collecting feedback from students of various colleges who were inspired and impressed by Ganitholsav-'23. We thank Principal and the management for permitting us to organise the programme successfully.

About the College

Sree Ayyappa College for Women came into existence in the year 1970. The institution established with the motto, 'Siksha Dharmena Shobathe' (Education Sparkles through Moral Excellence) is run by Sree Ayyappa Educational Society. The Society formed by the Malayalam speaking linguistic minority of Kanyakumari District and registered under the Societies Registration Act of 1955 founded a junior college in the year 1969. But as the greater need was for the higher education of women students the Management with the consent of the affiliated Madurai University converted the institution into a women's college in the next year. The college was vested with linguistic minority status in 1987.

The college is situated at the foot of Velimalai, the tail end of Western Ghats. The tranquillity and serenity of the idyllic surroundings provides congenial atmosphere for academic pursuits. Located close to the National Highways at a distance of 7 kilometres from Nagercoil, students gain easy access to transport facilities
