

Eligibility: i. Pass in the Higher Secondary Examination in the first or Second attempt.
ii. Community Certificate

Eligibility: i. No Income Limit
ii. Community Certificate to be produced.
4. SC/SC/ST Special Scholarship for students staying in Hostel.
5. Minority Welfare Scholarship for Christian & Muslim Students
6. Govt. of India Ministry of Labour Scholarship for Wards of Beedi Workers
7. Adhoc Merit Grant
Eligibility: i. Only for SC / ST converted students
ii. 60% and above marks obtained in Higher Secondary in the first attempt.
8. Govt. of India Scholarship for Physically Handicapped and Blind Welfare Scholarship

9. Adhi Dravida Scholarship for the Hindu Scheduled Caste Tribal Students.
Income limit is Rs. 2,50,000 per annum.
10. (i) M.S. University Merit Scholarship
(ii) National Merit Scholarship
11. Tamil medium students Incentive Cash Rs. 900/-
12. Tamil Nadu Educational Trust Fund, Kanniyakumari District.
i. Those who have scored the highest marks in plus two examination.
ii. Parents' Annual Income not to exceed Rs.12,000/-
iii. Scholarship if any received already should not exceed Rs.500/ - per annum.
iv. Only under graduate students are eligible to get scholarships irrespective of caste and community.
13. Freedom Fighter's Scholarship
i. Students whose parents have participated in the emancipation of India and have undergone a minimum of three months imprisonment are eligible for the award of the scholarship scheme besides fee concessions for their studies in colleges and professional courses of studies. Post graduate students are got eligible for this scholarship.
ii. Parental income not to exceed Rs. 12,000/-
14. Scholarship for the children of Defense service personnel Children of dependents of service personnel and Ex-Servicemen are awarded scholarships and fee concessions.
Eligibility: i. Should have scored 50% and above in the last examination attended.
15. K.P. Narayanan Nair Memorial Free Education Scheme for three economically deserving linguistic minority students.
16. E.V.R. Nagammair Scholarship for P.G. Students Income limit Rs.60,000/-.
17. Uzhavar Pathukappu Nala Thittam
18. Pudhumai Penn Scholarship

Eligibility: Student has studied in Govt. school from 6th to 12th Standard

19. EVR Uthavi Thokai for PG students from OC community
Annual income limit: Rs 1,00,000/-
