






REPORT FOR THE ACTIVITIES OF THE MONTH OF AUGUST 2022 'DRIVE AGAINST DRUGS '(DAD)






REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES FOR THE MONTH O F OCTOBER 2022:


NATIONAL WEBINAR ON WORLD AIDS DAY

All the volunteers were given e -certificates for their active participation in the webinar.




QUIZ PROGRAMME ON INTERNATIONAL YEAR OF MILLETS 2023

Similarly students who required further check-ups and medical attention were given proper advice by the medical team.
