Following the safety measures of Covid-19, a rally was conducted along the public roads to create awareness and encourage the use of masks and washing hands with soaps and sanitizers.

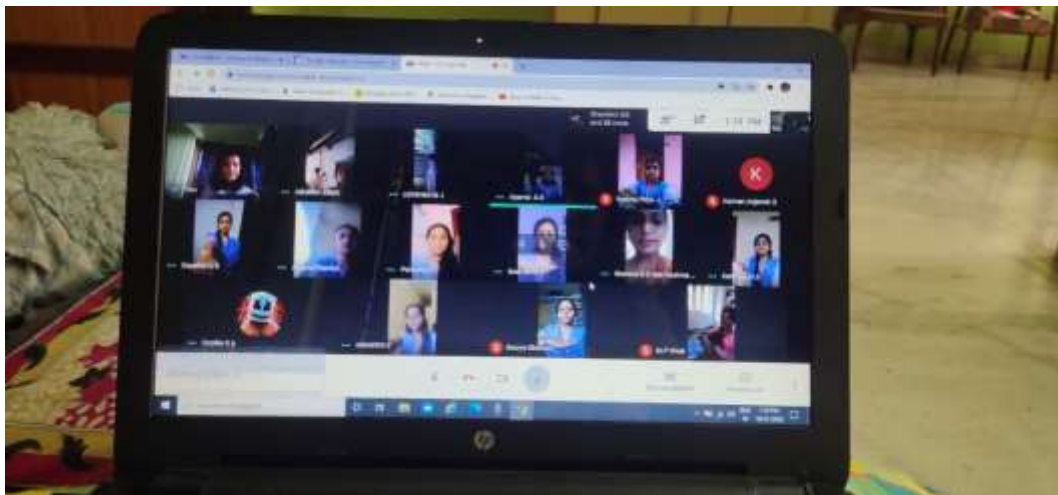


3) Honouring Sanitary workers on Nov 1, 2020

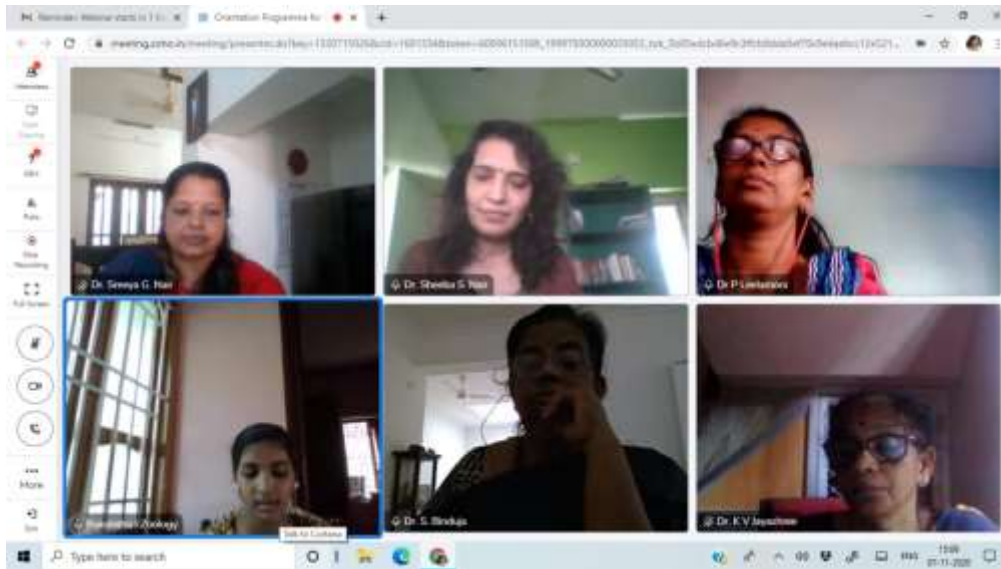

7) Diwali Celebration on Nov 13 2020

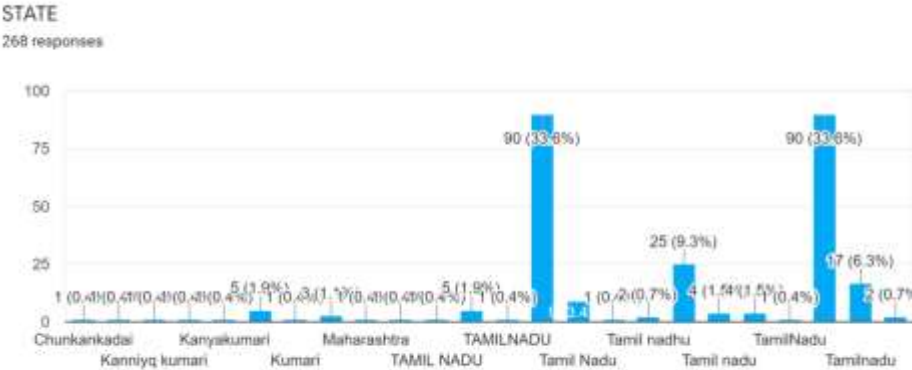
The volunteers celebrated Diwali by sharing sweets and wishes with the neighbours, thereby spreading the great message of communal harmony and love.

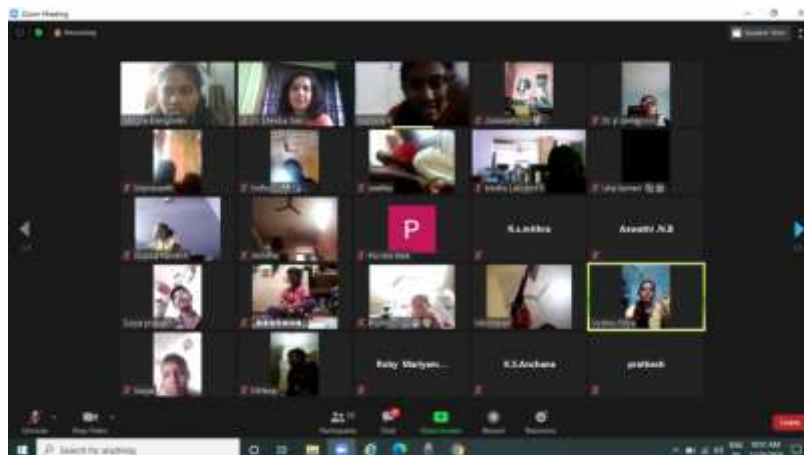

The Programme officer also attended the youth festival conducted at the Anna University campus and functioned as a judge for Creative writing.



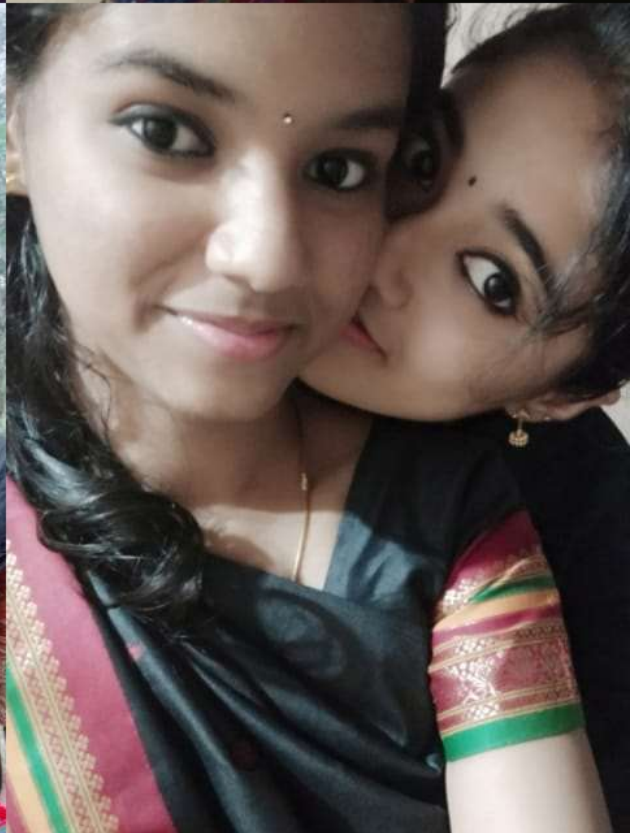
6) Webinar of Spoken English

1) Jan 1 Family Day

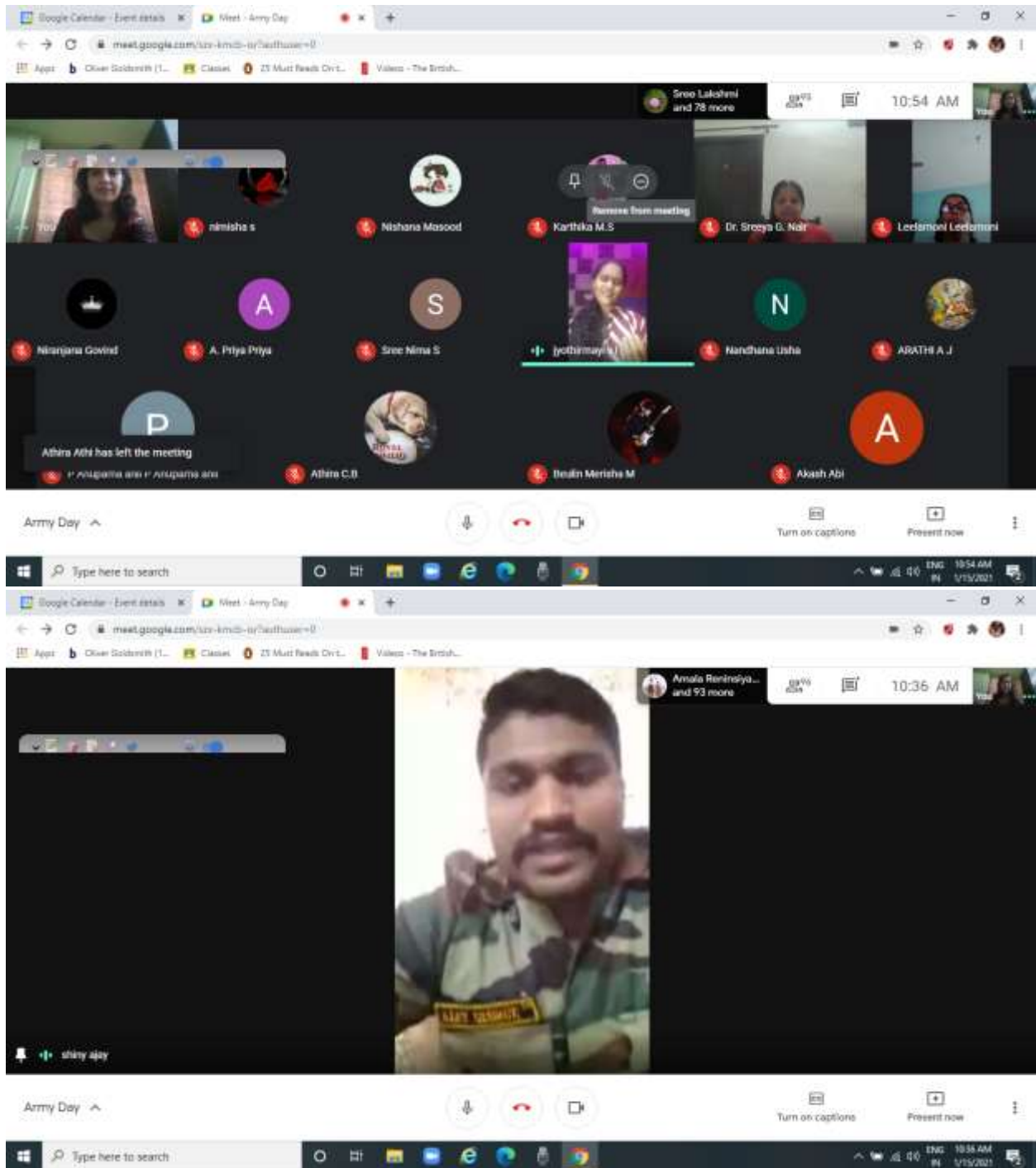
Family Day was celebrated by the volunteers. Any service must begin from home. Our volunteers expressed their love and bond to the members of the family and observed the day happily.

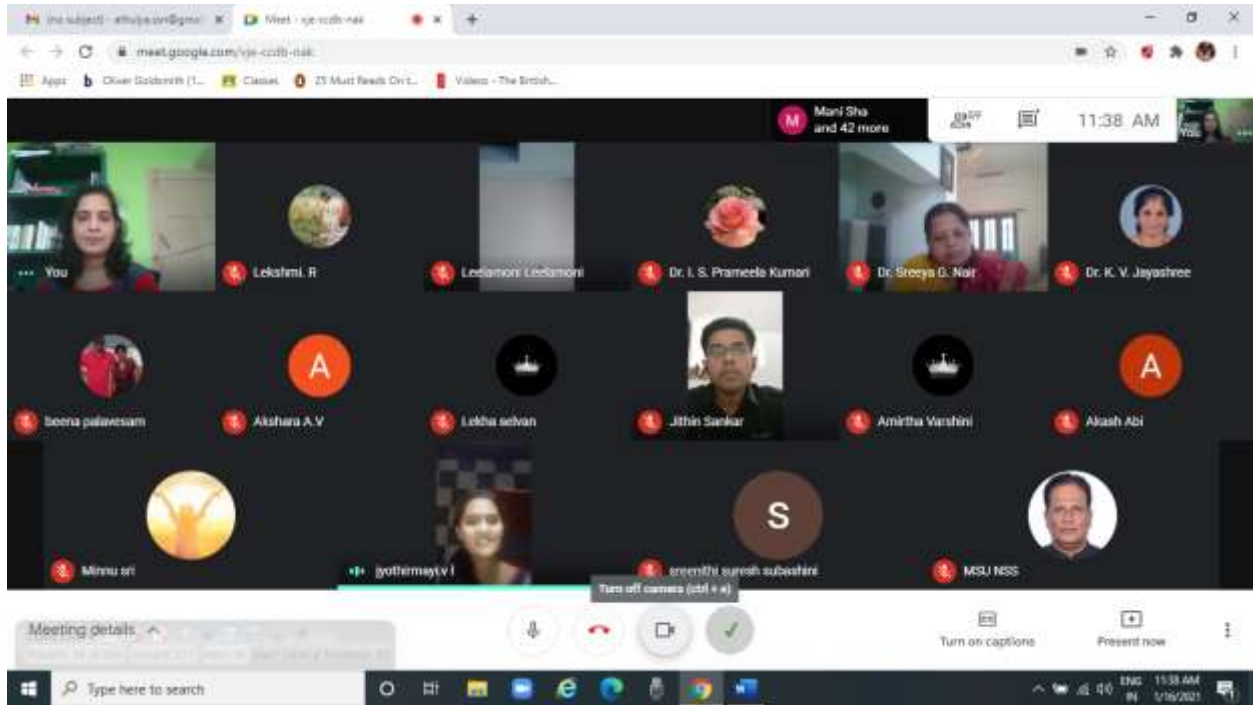

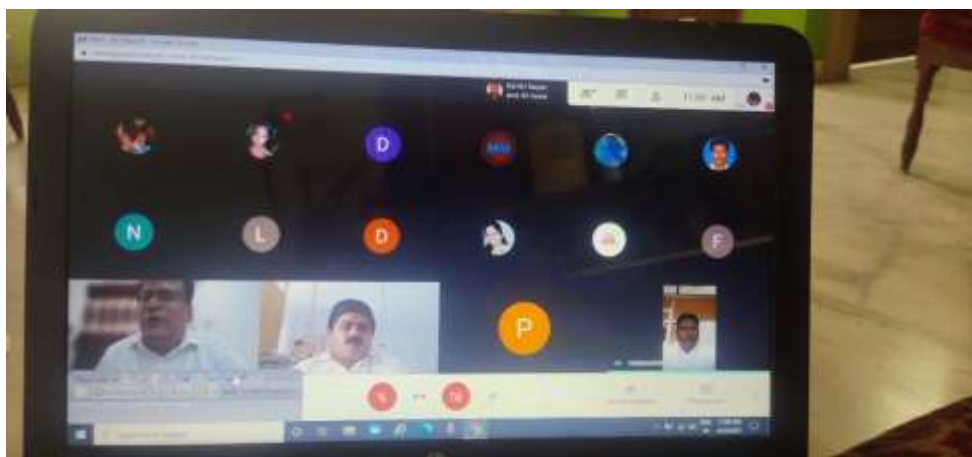
4) Awareness on Vaccination in the village 30 April 2021

Volunteers arranged a meeting with the villagers and explained to them regarding the importance of social distancing, wearing masks and vaccination.



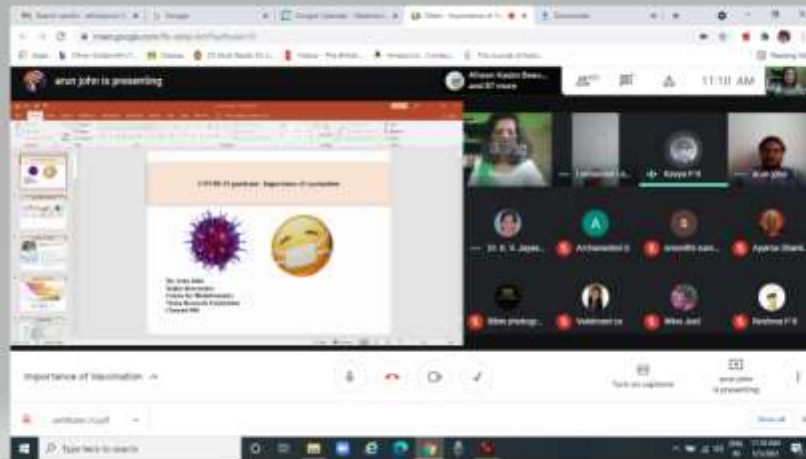
4) Webinar on 23 April 2021
