


RRC Report 2022

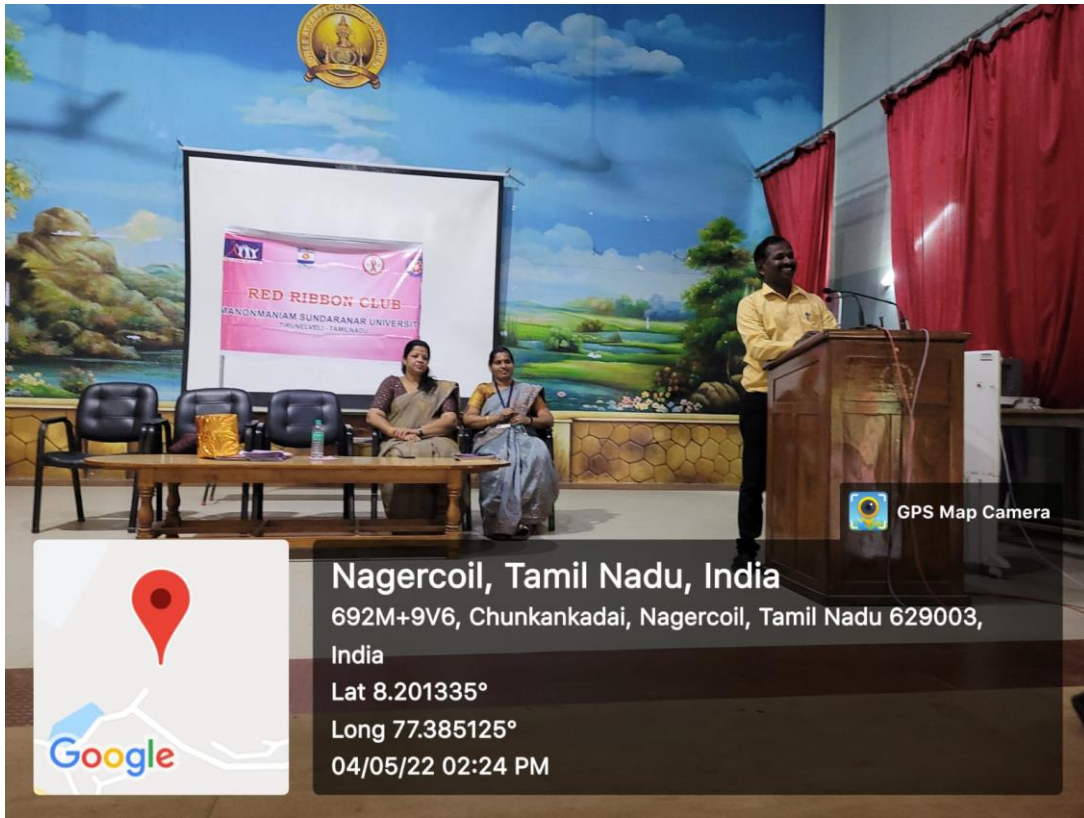


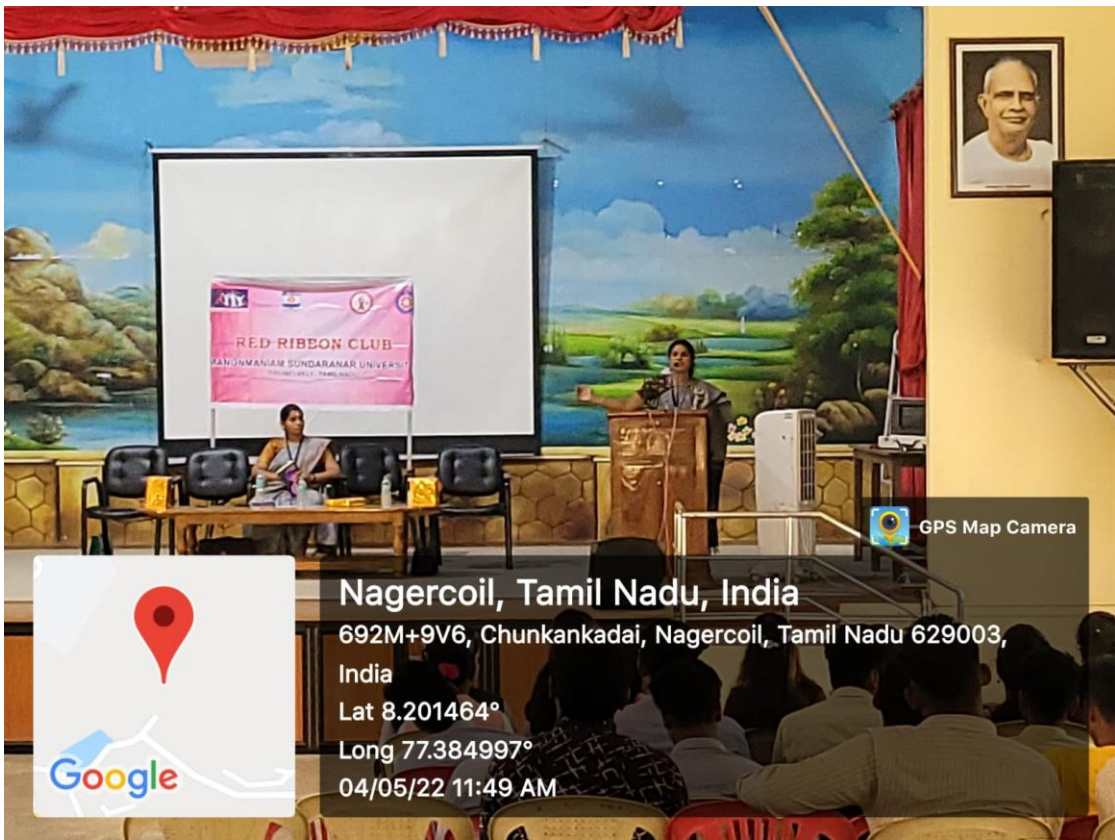


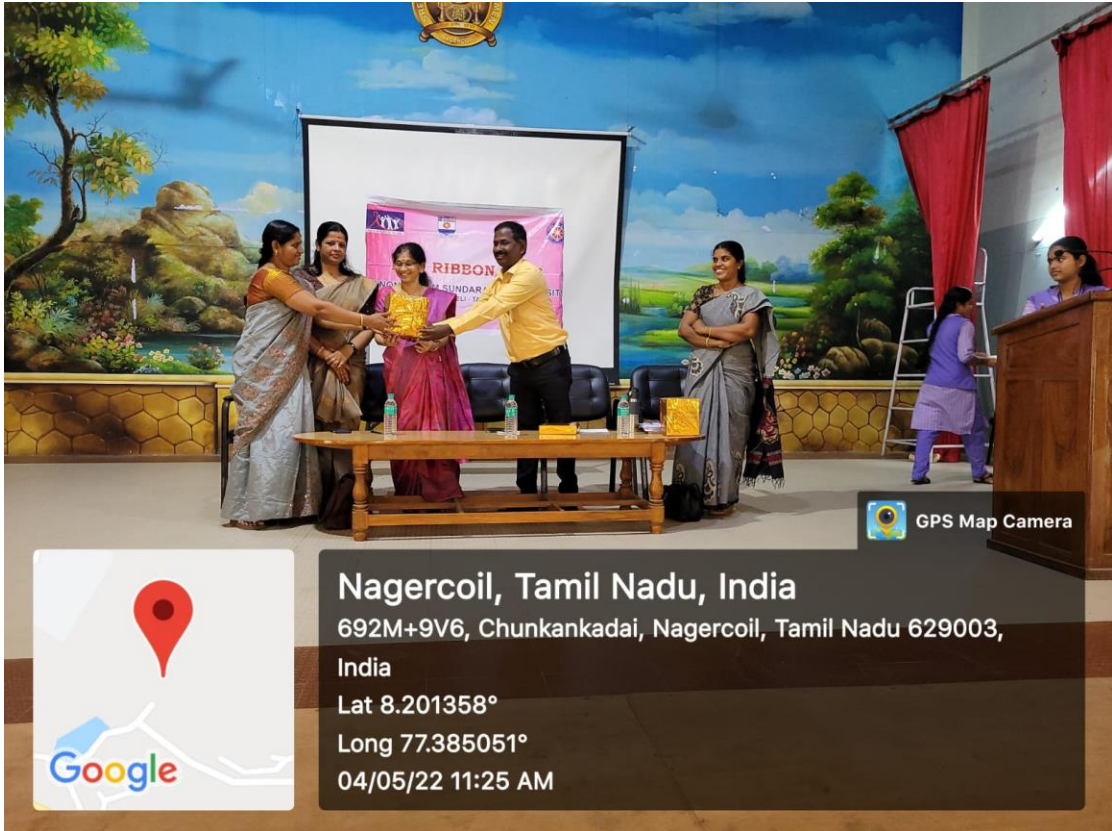
Peer Educators Training Programme for RRC volunteers of Kanyakumari district (4 May, 2022):

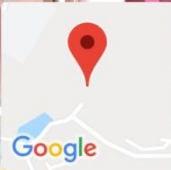
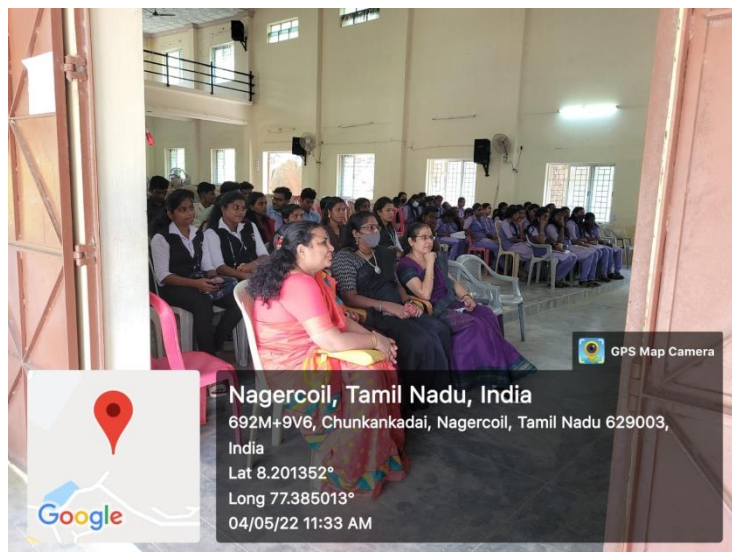
