
Report on the Alumni Meeting






Launching Futures: Alumni Engagement in Induction

• Q&A Session:


An engaging Q&A session allowed attendees to interact with the speakers, posing questions about their experiences and seeking advice on pursuing their careers in physics.








Branching Out: Alumni Perspectives on Botany Studies Department of Botany


Interactive session:


