




#### Orientation Program on 27/6/2023








# Report on Inauguration of Add-on Course on Mushroom Cultivation on 24-01-2024


# <u>Field Report: Exposure Visit to NARDEP, Vivekananda Kendra Kanyakumari on 05/04/2024</u>












#### Women's Day Celebration on 07 March 2024










# **International Cultural Interaction Programme on 21-12-2023**



#### **Insights to Inspire on 07/03/2024**








# Librarian's Day Celebration On 23rd August 2023






# Report on Inter-Departmental Poster Making Competition Organized by Anti-Drug Club on 22nd December 2023
