AND

Sree Ayyappa College for Women, Chunkankadai, Kanyakumari District- 629 003, Tamil Nadu, India, the Second Party represented herein by its Head of the Institution Principal Dr. V.R. Anjana (hereinafter referred to as the 'Second Party'), the institution, which expression unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context, shall include its successors-in-office, administrators, and assigns.

PURPOSE OF MOU

In particular ,this MOU is intended to

- 1. Provide a wide range of courses and workshops, both for a fee and for free: The MOU aims to offer a diverse array of educational opportunities to the students. These opportunities may include both paid and free courses and workshops that cover a broad range of topics, from technical skills to soft skills.
- 2. Organize a session of orientation: The MOU intends to hold an orientation session that will aid the students in comprehending the objectives and goals of the program. This session may also provide an overview of the courses and workshops that will be offered, as well as any other relevant information.
- 3. Organize workshops: The MOU may also involve the organization of workshops, seminars, courses, which may be led by experts in the field. These seminars may delve deeply into a particular topic and provide an opportunity for students to ask questions and engage in discussions.
- **4. Internships:** Finally, the MOU aims to provide opportunities for internships at their centre for deserving candidates with adequate capabilities.

NOW THEREFORE, INCONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Clause1

CO-OPERATION

- 1.1. Both parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and cooperation that will promote and advance their respective operations. The parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and share all information that may be relevant to securing additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2. The cooperation between the First Party and the Second Party will facilitate the effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the First Party by providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching and training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the Second Party.
- 1.3. The Second Party shall be obliged to allow its students to participate in an internship program offered by the First Party. This will enable the students to gain practical experience and enhance their knowledge and skills in their respective fields.

1.4. The scheduled workshops and courses shall be authorized to take place on the specified day, subject to any unforeseen circumstances or emergencies. This will ensure that the students can attend the workshops and courses as planned and derive maximum benefit from them. Both parties shall make every effort to avoid envescheduling conflicts or other issues that may are selected.

SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.1. Both parties acknowledge that close cooperation between them would significantly benefit the student community by enhancing their skills and knowledge. This collaboration would enable the students to gain practical experience and be better prepared for their future careers.
- 2.2. The First Party shall provide valuable insights to the Second Party on teaching/training methodologies that would enable the students to fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully. This input would be based on the First Party's experience and expertise in the field.
- 2.3. The interaction between both parties shall provide insights into the latest developments/requirements of the industries. The First Party shall permit the Faculty and Students of the Second Party to visit its office and participate in Training Programs. This training and exposure would build confidence and prepare the students for a smooth transition from academic to working careers.
- 2.4. The First Party shall train the students of the Second Party on emerging technologies, bridging the gap in skills and making them ready for industry. This training shall be based on the latest industry trends and technologies.
- 2.5. The First Party shall assist in placing students of the Second Party into internships/jobs. This assistance shall be based on the First Party's industry connections and expertise, enabling the students to secure suitable internships/jobs that align with their interests and career goals.

Clause 3

REMUNERATION

- 3.1. Following discussions, both parties have agreed that the Second Party shall pay 50% of the course/workshop fees upfront, and the remaining 50% shall be paid halfway through the course/workshop. This payment structure shall be applicable to all paid courses and workshops offered by the First Party, subject to any specific terms and conditions agreed upon by both parties.
- 3.2. In the event that the Second Party issues a letter of recommendation to facilitate a student's enrollment in a course offered by the First Party, the First Party shall offer a concession of 10-20% on the prescribed course fees.

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Clause 4

VALIDITY

4.1 This MOU will become effective, beginning on the day after the last party has signed. This MOU may be reviewed annually on or around the anniversary of its effective date. The term may be extended for a further period with mutual consent in writing by both parties, during which period the Second Party will take effective steps for the implementation of this MOU. This MOU may only be modified by the written agreement of the parties, duly signed by their authorized representatives.

4.2 This MOU may be terminated by either party after giving the other party 30 days written notice of the intent to terminate. In the event of termination, both parties must dislodge their obligations. Any act on the part of both the parties after termination of this Agreement, by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be considered as an extension of this MOU.

Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MOU shall be resolved by mutual discussion.
