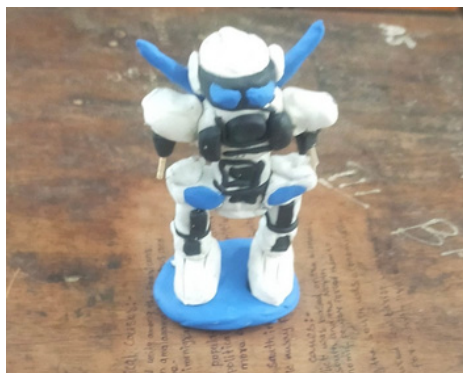

**Stretching Towards Serenity:** Yoga demonstration by Ramprasad of Class IX of N.M.Vidya Kendra, Chitharal.




